

PURPOSE

Generate rich associations while keeping every possibility anchored to the dreamer, the dream, and the evidence.

1 Select exact language

Underline one word or phrase and copy it without changing the wording.

2 Generate several possibilities

Record immediate, personal, historical, cultural, emotional, sensory, and scriptural associations.

3 Name function

Ask what the selected detail does in this dream, what it affects, and how it changes across the sequence.

4 Keep alternatives open

Allow multiple plausible meanings to remain until context, sequence, outcome, testing, and prayer narrow them.

WORKING QUESTIONS

- What does this exact phrase evoke for this dreamer?
- Which memory, relationship, responsibility, culture, or present season changes its weight?
- What emotion or sensory response accompanies it?
- Which alternative meaning deserves a fair hearing?
- Which dream detail supports or limits each possibility?
