

PURPOSE

Evaluate meaning through biography, present season, culture, relationships, function, change, and outcome.

1 Personal history

Identify memories, formative experiences, preferences, wounds, gifts, responsibilities, and repeated life themes connected to the detail.

2 Present season

Name current decisions, relationships, transitions, prayers, conflicts, opportunities, griefs, and practical facts.

3 Cultural and scriptural context

Record relevant language, community meaning, biblical teaching in context, and the limits of the connection.

4 Dream function

Trace what the detail does, receives, blocks, opens, carries, reveals, changes, or becomes by the final scene.

WORKING QUESTIONS

- Where has this appeared in the dreamer's real history?
- What current circumstance makes this detail timely?
- How would the dreamer's culture or community understand it?
- What role does it play in the sequence?
- How do relationships and the final outcome reshape its meaning?

How does the selected detail serve the complete movement of the dream, and which context gives that function its clearest meaning?
