HOW WERE YOU INTRODUCED TO THE PROPHETIC?

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QUESTION 1

How I Was Introduced to the Prophetic

How were you introduced to the prophetic? Did someone prophesy over you? Did you see a prophet minister at your church?

I was first introduced to the prophetic as a young person by hearing prophets minister in churches. I watched them speak publicly to individuals and congregations, sometimes revealing personal matters and delivering strong messages. Although I recognized that prophetic ministry carried spiritual authority, I also felt afraid of it. Some prophets did not seem soft, kind, or gentle in their delivery, and I worried that my private business might be displayed before everyone.

My earliest introduction, therefore, came primarily through seeing and hearing prophets minister in church. Over time, people also prophesied over me. Those experiences became increasingly meaningful as the words I received consistently aligned with what God had already been showing me, confirmed aspects of my identity and calling, and helped me recognize His direction more clearly.

My early fear also shaped the kind of prophet I desire to become. I want people who receive ministry from me to encounter the heart of God through love, dignity, wisdom, humility, gentleness, and responsible stewardship. I am learning that transparency and vulnerability can serve God powerfully while still honoring appropriate boundaries and protecting the dignity of everyone involved.

QUESTION 2

When I Learned That I May Be Prophetic

When did you learn that you may be prophetic?

I first began to recognize that I might be prophetic approximately twenty-five years ago, while I was in college. That was when the prophetic gift began flourishing in my own life. I began perceiving spiritual meaning, recognizing what God was communicating, and experiencing an awareness that extended beyond ordinary observation.

My understanding developed further through foundational teaching and early prophetic activation at The Well in Connecticut. Additional training and prophetic ministry experiences in Minnesota and Wisconsin helped me recognize that these experiences formed a continuing pattern in my life.

In 2022, a spiritual gifts assessment identified prophecy as my strongest gift. This provided another clear confirmation of what had been developing for many years. During 2026, the calling became substantially clearer through an accelerated season of prophetic formation involving local church training, a fourteen-day missional journey through the northeastern United States, the Christian International Watchman Conference, Bethel School of the Prophets, the Bethel Emerging Prophets community, and Christian International School of the Prophets.

I now understand that God began forming me prophetically long before I had language for the calling. The gift began flourishing in college, developed through more than two decades of experience and preparation, and entered a concentrated season of recognition, training, activation, and maturation in 2026. I am now growing into greater transparency and vulnerability as I embrace my call as a prophet and learn to steward it with biblical faithfulness, mature character, compassion, courage, and love.

A SEER PROPHET INSIGHT

The Seer Prophet course has been especially helpful to me because it has expanded my understanding of how the seer dimension operates through me. I once assumed that, as a Seer Prophet, I would need to wait until I saw a vision before I could share. Yet God has been causing revelation to bubble up abundantly within me. As I open my mouth, He gives me the words to speak or sing, sometimes with an accompanying vision and sometimes without one. I already understood that seeing, speaking, and singing are vessels through which His revelation flows, and that revelation can begin in more than one way. God is now emphasizing this truth within me with greater clarity and prominence. He is causing me to experience how abundantly revelation can bubble up as I open my mouth to speak or sing, with or without an accompanying vision.
