MY SYNTHESIS OF MY NOTES

Yet He exhorts them to carry out that calling in the context of the community of believers. And yet, we will be advancing in community with others. Each person is unique, and each person is bringing a different set of fears, uncertainty, faith, experience, wisdom, expectation, growth. Each person has a unique calling, purpose, vision, mission, purpose on their life, and God has equipped them for that specific unique purpose for which He has called them, and He chooses to have us in community as we advance together with our various levels of uncertainty and preparation and zeal. And some of us will charge ahead, and some of us will follow, and some of us will have supportive roles, and every person has a role. Everyone will play a role in this work that God is doing in and through His bride. And there will be roadblocks that will be encountered that we won't be able to predict necessarily. But what we can predict is that we know the God who already is aware of all the roadblocks that can occur. He already sees them. He already knows them, and He already has planned a way for us to overcome them and to supersede and rise above them. And we will rise on wings like eagles, and He will show us the path. He will show us the way when we encounter the roadblock, and He helps us rise above it through His glory and through His greatness and through His grace and His mercy, not by our own effort, not by even the efforts of those around us, because God is the one who gets the glory. So even as we are obedient and take the steps to advance, and even as those around us, also in community, charge ahead in advancing His kingdom, we cannot do it alone. And He is the one who deserves all the glory and all the praise and all the trust and all the faith.
