Dr. Sherry-Ann Brown is a physician-scientist cardiologist, educator, investigator, innovator, entrepreneur, and prophetic missionary whose service joins healthcare, Christian formation, research, education, enterprise, community outreach, and an emerging public-service sphere. Her nation is leaders and emerging leaders carrying consequential responsibility for the lives and flourishing of others.

She is the first and only cardiologist licensed in all fifty states and Washington, DC, and one of a limited number of internists with this reach. Her service mark, “America’s Expert Cardiologist,” is pending national trademark-registration acceptance.

- Medical-school healthcare advocacy on Capitol Hill as a member of the American Medical Student Association, including direct discussion with a senator’s representative.
- Recipient of a travel award during Mayo Clinic cardiology fellowship to attend the 2016 American College of Cardiology Legislative Conference in Washington, DC.
- ACC/Mayo Clinic FITS-on-the-GO editorial-board service and Legislative Conference interviews, including an advocacy interview with Dr. Minnow Walsh and a professional record of interviewing NIH Director Francis Collins.
- Prior grassroots ACC advocacy participation, with the Cardio Advocacy Network as the strongest match for the remembered program name; related familiarity with ACCPAC, now HeartPAC.
- Security clearance from the Social Security Administration for anticipated disability case-review service; administrative and electronic-communication delays limited continuation.
- International civic relationship in the Dominican Republic through introduction to the area governor, whose relative blessing accompanied mission access, and through the Monte Coca family patriarch regarded informally as the community mayor.
- Community engagement in Philadelphia alongside community leaders while serving and discipling pre-health professional students preparing for future leadership.
- Developing interest in nonpartisan healthcare counsel, federal commissions, expert testimony, public comments, professional-society advocacy, and faith-informed service to public leaders.
- Regional government–enterprise interface through Lynn Kroesen, Manager of the Hillsborough County Entrepreneur Collaborative Center, following her presentation at the ARISE entrepreneurship meeting.

Ministry to Spiritual and Emerging Leaders

- Prayer ministry for pastors’ wives during a recent northeastern mission.
- Prayer for leaders of a Connecticut street ministry and encouragement of those carrying frontline responsibility.
- Medical-education and spiritual mission service in Cuba.

- Discipleship and formation of pre-health students in Philadelphia as future healthcare and community leaders.
- Approximately a decade of integrated medical and spiritual mission service in Monte Coca and the Dominican Republic through clinics, teaching, preaching, prayer, giving, and discipleship.
